## History of the Mushroom tunnel in NSW Vimeo Video



Li Sun Exotic Mushrooms are grown in a very special tunnel in NSW. This tunnel was built in the 19<sup>th</sup> century as a railway tunnel.

By 1942 the tunnel was used to store explosives during World War II.

In 1987, Dr Noel Arrol, a microbiologist took it over after discovering the environmental conditions of the tunnel, particularly the low temperature and high humidity, were ideal for growing mushrooms.
